

PERMANENT MAKEUP CONCEPT (PMC) 2017

PREREQUISITES:

- Permanent Make-Up (micro-pigmentation) requires the practitioner to perform very fine work while handling clients who may be anxious or nervous. Therefore, ideal candidates for PMC Permanent Make-Up training will have good eyesight, steady hands, dexterity, and the ability to communicate and function calmly in a stressful situation.
- This is a fast-paced class that requires the student to quickly put into practice the techniques they have learned.
- Previous training in Make-Up Artistry and/or Colour Theory will be an asset to you.
- For the health and safety of the models, the protection of the student, and to ensure students are able to pass their exams, **students must have high proficiency in written and spoken English.**

MODEL INFORMATION

• Students will work on dummies, each other, and on models in class. Students are responsible for securing models for class. Please advise your models that a model fee of \$75.00 per session will apply, cash only. The tentative model schedule is as follows, but is subject to change:

- o Day 3 2:00pm (lip liner)
- o Day 4 2:00pm (brows)
- o Day 5 9:30am (eye liner), 11:30am (any), 2:30pm (any)

• Your models must be in good health and NOT diabetic, currently experiencing allergies, or prone to hypertrophic/keloid scarring, nor have any auto-immune disorder. They should also NOT be taking any medication that thins the blood, including aspirin and herbal supplements, nor antibiotics. They should NOT have any condition that affects their ability to heal or fight infection. Other contra-indications also exist, which you will learn about in class, at which point you may discover you need to change some of your models. These treatments perforate the skin, therefore if you or a model is in doubt about their candidacy for this treatment, they should consult a physician before undergoing this procedure. If your model is disqualified at the instructor's discretion, cancels, or does not arrive, you are responsible for scheduling another model session with the instructor before you may begin your quotas, for which you will be charged a fee. It is recommended that you secure "back-up" models. Question your potential models carefully to ensure they are a candidate for this procedure and ensure they are aware of the model fee.

• Models must be at least 18 years of age.

• Out-of-class quotas are required to participate in the exams. The quota requirements are 10 lip liner or lipshade sessions, 10 brow sessions, and 10 eye liner or lash enhancement sessions. Students are required to arrange their own quotas. Models will probably require more than one session, therefore each model will most likely count toward more than one quota.



• A written and practical exam will be administered on Day 6. The exam day will be scheduled with you by your instructor. You will be required to perform a lip, a brow, and an eye service on a model. You may use more than one model. Model fee applies. The tentative schedule for Day 6 is as follows, but is subject to change:

- o 9:00AM WRITTEN EXAM
- o 11:00AM BROWS
- o 1:30PM LIP LINER
- o 3:30PM EYE LINER

CLASS INFORMATION:

- 50% of the course cost is required to confirm registration, and this deposit is **non-refundable** should you decide to cancel. The remaining balance is due on the first class day.
- As with all classes at the Esthetic Institute, students are expected to arrive in school uniform, which is professional attire appropriate for the spa/esthetic environment (jeans, sneakers, and sweats/hoodies are NOT considered professional attire). **Students are encouraged to wear dark-coloured clothing.**
- A **Black** Lab Jacket is required (available for purchase at Beauty Depot). This is the only class for which a black jacket is required. Please bring a pair of indoor soft soled dress shoes.
- Be prepared to pull back long hair and/or pin back long bangs/fringe.
- Please bring with you the following to class: paper, pen, pencil, highlighter.
- Many materials for in-class models will be provided by the school and in your kit, however students are required to purchase some additional materials to use in class to complete their out-of-class quotas.
- On the first day of class, please arrive 15 minutes prior to your start time to allow for check-in and payment at the Beauty Depot. On subsequent days, please ensure that you are here on time and prepared for class. If you are unable to be on time for whatever reason, you are expected to call and notify your instructor prior to class start time. If you are unable to get through to the main line, you may leave a message at ext 3. If you are more than 30 minutes late without prior notice, you will need to reschedule the entire class with our Education Director. A Rescheduling Fee of \$250 applies to any student who misses a class day(s) or needs to change a course or exam date.
- You will receive a 30 minute lunch break. A bagged lunch can be brought. Please note, smoking is only permitted at the side of the building.
- Please park your vehicle on the West side of the building. Please ensure you have picked up your **parking pass** (from The Esthetic Institute) and that it is in your vehicle in a visible location.
- All class dates are subject to change. We reserve the right to reschedule or cancel any class.
- There is a fee of \$250 to reschedule the exams again should you not pass the first time.
